

York Catholic Athletic Association Meeting
October 21, 2015 – YCHS Faculty Dining Room

Members in attendance: Carlos Castellanos, Stephanie Freed, Marc Ryan, Rick Luckman, Stephen Leshner, Christina Leshner, and Shelby Yinger.

Call to Order and Opening Prayer – President Carlos Castellanos called the meeting to order. The meeting opened with a prayer led by Stephanie Freed at 6:30 pm.

MINUTES: The minutes from the meeting held on August 19, 2015 were distributed to the members present at the meeting. Marc Ryan noted that these minutes were not yet posted on the York Catholic webpage but would be after the approval. A motion was then made by Rick Luckman to approve the minutes, seconded by Shelby Yinger. The minutes were unanimously approved.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Steve Leshner presented the financial report as of September 30, 2015 indicating that the YCAA had the following balances in the accounts as of that date: Checking account - \$18,888.91; savings account - \$36,180.99; total funds was \$55,069.90 as of September 30, 2015. Steve also reported on the profit and loss detail provided to the members in attendance for the months of July, August and September 2015. Net profit for the three months was \$7,882.96. There was a brief discussion on the financial report that included questions from the members present on the bingo income and expenses. Rick Luckman commented on the increasing costs of bus transportation for teams and recent purchases for new uniforms including varsity cheerleading, girls' soccer, and girls' basketball. He added that the costs for these uniforms was about \$9,000 of which about \$4,300 was donated. A motion was made by Rick Luckman to approve the report, Christina Leshner second, and the financial report was unanimously approved.

OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS: The following new business items were discussed:

Hall of Fame – Rick Luckman and Carlos Castellanos discussed the upcoming YC Hall of Fame inductions which will be on Saturday, January 9 during the basketball game that afternoon. There was a brief discussion. Chris Leshner volunteered to help with the Hall of Fame committee.

AD REPORT: Rick Luckman provided the following updates:

Fall season is winding down with football, girls' soccer, and girls' volleyball all qualifying for the District 3 tournaments. He briefly updated everyone on the known games coming up for districts. He commented on the continued success of the teams and also recognized the boys' soccer team for a good season considering the many injuries they had.

Winter season is gearing up with basketball opening on December 5 with the slate of games against Trinity. He also discussed the new PIAA classifications and where YC would fall for the majority of their sports. There was a brief discussion.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: The following Committee reports were presented:

BOOSTER – Rick Luckman gave a brief update on the 2015 booster drive indicating that donations are down from previous years.

FUNDRAISING - Stephanie Freed discussed the bingo schedule and volunteer help at the recent bingos. The next two bingos will be on November 1 and on December 6. There was a brief discussion on fundraising in general with Carlos and Rick commenting that fundraising has been stagnant for both bingo and gates and that new ways to raise funds need to be looked at. Shelby Yinger asked about Vince Bulik's idea to have a fundraising event with the York Revolution. Carlos answered that the idea must be presented and approved by the YC administration.

GATES, BANNERS, PROGRAM – Carlos Castellanos gave a brief report.

RECRUITMENT, MEMBERSHIP – There was no report.

COMMUNICATIONS – There was no report.

IRISH NIGHT – There was a brief report and discussion.

CORRESPONDENCES: There was no correspondence.

NEXT MEETING: Next meeting of the YCAA was scheduled for Wednesday, December 9, 2015 at 6:30 pm.
