

Dual Enrollment The Fast Facts

- Dual Enrollment earns you college credit right here at York Catholic. Our teachers provide the instruction and award you a grade. Whatever grade you earn here is the grade that will appear on your Alvernia transcript. (A 90 is an A- on the Alvernia scale.)
- If you opt to take a Dual Enrollment course, there will be enrichment and you will have additional assignments above and beyond the standard curriculum.
- Most colleges have pre-requisite courses in psychology and language. You can fulfill that obligation with dual enrollment your senior year.
- Foreign Language study via Alvernia is a six credit investment. Please know that if you register for Spanish or French the tuition will be \$750.00. (The one time enrollment fee would bring that to \$775.00.)
- If you compare costs, Alvernia is reasonable and much more affordable than either Penn State York or York College.

Penn State York	Per Credit Dual Enrollment \$260.00
Alvernia University	Per Credit Dual Enrollment \$125.00

- Dual Enrollment is altogether different than Advanced Placement as offered through College Board. AP courses are offered at York Catholic at no additional expense to the student other than the cost of testing, which is \$89.00. AP tests are administered in May and most colleges and universities require a score of a 3 or higher in order to be awarded college credit. The grading scale is 1-5; a 5 is the highest possible score. York Catholic currently offers AP courses in US History, English, Chemistry, Calculus, and Biology.
