I hope this letter finds you enjoying the end of summer days and cooler fall evenings. As we enter the 2019-2020 school year, the YC family has so many blessings to celebrate. Our graduates once again proved that a YC education allows for the best college and career opportunities for the future. Our alumni and friends demonstrated their confidence in our school through their generous support of our Capital Campaign, allowing for new air conditioned classrooms and the installation of a new turf field to welcome back the students. And our school board has adopted a 5-year strategic plan to ensure success for another 90 years of Catholic education in York County.

While our Capital Campaign has seen success beyond imagined, our operating costs must continue to be met in order to fulfill the important mission of a York Catholic education. With our cost per pupil exceeding \$9,000.00 per student for the 2019-2020 school year (still well below the county and national average), we rely on our generous friends' and families' support of the York Catholic Fund to maintain an average tuition cost of \$6,000.00, all while recruiting and retaining the most talented faculty in the area.

This past year, we graduated 104 young men and women who will go on to use the foundation of their YC education to shape the future of our communities. These young men and women set school records, achieving one of the highest average SAT scores in school history and earning over 13 million dollars in college scholarship offers. Through the generous support of our donors, we were able to maintain one of the lowest secondary school tuition costs in the Diocese of Harrisburg, provide 43% of our student body with financial assistance, and increase student programs and curriculum offerings.

It is our hope that you will continue to support our students in their journey, showing our YC family, our local York County community, and the Diocese of Harrisburg that a York Catholic education continues to be the education of choice in the York area.

I look forward to seeing you around campus this year. Thank you for your consideration and support of our wonderful school and students.
