What:	York Catholic Prom (supervised by York Catholic faculty)
Who:	All York Catholic Juniors and Seniors. York Catholic Sophomores may attend as the date of a YC junior or senior. YC students are permitted to bring guests as dates by permission. Guests must be no younger than 10 th , 11 th , or 12 th grade and no older than 20. Permission slips can be obtained from Mrs. Emschweiler.
When:	Friday, April 29, 2022 Doors open at 5:00 PM. Students must be in the Grand Ballroom by 5:30 PM. Dinner is served at 6:30 PM. The Dance ends at 10:00 PM. Students leaving before that time must allow a chaperone to confirm their departure with a parent by phone. Students may not return to the dance once they have departed.
Where:	Wisehaven Banquet Center – Grand Ballroom 2985 East Prospect Road York, PA 17402
Cost:	\$60 per person (includes dinner & dance) Cash or check made out to York Catholic. Tickets will be on sale outside of room 112 at the following times: Monday, April 11: 8:00-8:15 AM and 3-3:30 PM. Tuesday, April 12: 8:00-8:15 AM and 3-3:30 PM. Wednesday, April 13: 8:00-8:15 AM and 11:30 AM-12 noon. Tickets will not be sold during the day or during lunch periods.
Dress Code & Expectations:	See the Formal Dress Code and Formal Dance Expectations for Homecoming & Prom. Each student attending (male and female and guests) and a parent must sign the Formal Dress Code Agreement and Formal Dance Expectations Agreement. The Agreement(s) must be returned before tickets can be purchased.
Guests from Other Schools:	A Formal Dance Guest Request Form, Formal Dance Expectations, and Formal Dress Code Agreement(s) are due at the time of ticket purchase. These forms can be found on the YC website at www.yorkcatholic.org under the Parents & Students section on the Forms & Documents page. Mr. Miller will give the YC student a Guest Ticket that must be presented at check-in the night of the dance.
Seating:	Attendees should discuss who they prefer to sit with at dinner so those requests can be made at the time of ticket purchase. Tables seat 8 people.
Photos:	Professional pictures will not be taken the night of the dance. Candid photos will be taken during the dance and available for purchase from Lifetouch.

FORMAL DRESS CODE

Homecoming & Prom

The following guidelines have been established to help make York Catholic's formal dances (Homecoming & Prom) enjoyable and memorable evenings.

All young men and women in attendance, whether a member of the York Catholic student body or a guest of a York Catholic student, need to be dressed in formal wear and must comply with the rules and regulations of YC and the YC dress code.

For Young Ladies

Gowns may not:

- Be shorter than two inches above the knee
- Be extremely low cut front or back
- Have slits higher than the knee
- Have bare midriffs or cut outs
- Have transparent or translucent material
- Have nude or flesh-tone colored material as a primary or secondary base color

For Young Men:

- Must wear a suit or sport coat, dress shirt, and tie
- Must wear dress shoes (sneakers are not permitted)
- May not wear earrings
- Must be clean shaven

We hope students will use common sense and good judgment when choosing formal attire. The York Catholic administration will be the final judges the night of the event as to what is appropriate attire. Those who choose to disregard these guidelines will be asked to contact a parent the night of the dance to bring suitable formal wear or will be asked to leave. Refunds will not be provided to students who violate this dress code. We look forward to an enjoyable and memorable evening. FORMAL DANCE EXPECTATIONS

Homecoming & Prom

Students are reminded that attending a York Catholic formal dance is a privilege and along with that come responsibilities. All formal dance attendees agree to adhere to the following expectations:

- All students must arrive no later than 5:30 PM.
- Students may not leave prior to 10 PM.
- If a guest from another school comes with a YC student, the guest must present their Guest Slip and ID at the check-in table.
- Students must stay on the main floor and may not move to the balcony or go outside.
- All students are expected to give speakers, presenters, chaperones, and servers their full attention and respect.
- All students are expected to follow the Formal Dress Code found on the Formal Dress Code Agreement form.
- All dancing must be face to face. There should be no dancing front to back. Students may not dance in clusters to obscure the view of chaperones.
- Public displays of affection are not permitted.
- Students and guests must comply with the rules and regulations of York Catholic.
- Violations of these expectations may lead to parent notification and early dismissal from the dance.

In order to provide this environment, we ask that all guests who are not current York Catholic students or who have not graduated from York Catholic who wish to attend our Prom or Homecoming Dance meet the following requirements:

- Be the age of 20 or under.
- Be of the opposite sex of the YC student host.
- Be at least a sophomore in high school for Prom.
- Be at least a freshman in high school for Homecoming.
- Have no criminal record.
- Have no discipline matters pending at his/her school.
- Be recommended by an administrator from his/her school if applicable.
- Follow the dress code policies and expectations for formal dances.
- Present photo ID when entering the dance.

If the guest is employed or in the military, then his/her immediate supervisor/superior must give his/her recommendation. If the student is attending college and unemployed, then no administrator signature is required. If the guest is a graduate or former student of York Catholic High School, a check will be done on his/her discipline record during the last year of enrollment at the school.
