



TIMELINE FOR JUNIORS

- This year's grades really count. Get help from teachers if you do not understand something. Don't let problems go unattended – talk with your teacher about getting extra help. **Attendance** counts as well, and is part of your permanent record.
- Continue to consider careers, college majors, and potential post-secondary options. We will be working with the online SCOIR system this year for career exploration.
- Attend college representative visits when a college of interest visits York Catholic. Check your Google classroom and the bulletin board outside the guidance office for upcoming college visits.
- Visit college campuses and take college tours. Make a point to visit schools in which you are interested in attending and speak with students who attend those schools.
- Attend local college fairs. York College holds a large fair every year.
- Try to narrow your college choices to five or less institutions and request application materials from those schools online.
- Be aware of the deadlines for scholarships and early admissions to schools (typically very early in the fall of your senior year).
- Consider a dual enrollment opportunity for your senior year. Earn college credit that counts towards high school AND college at a discounted rate!
- Know what tests are required by the post-secondary institutions that you are considering (SAT I, SAT II, or ACT).
- All juniors will take the PSAT at York Catholic on the morning of Wednesday, October 12. Discuss your results with your parents and guidance counselor. Practice on the [College Board](#) website is also encouraged.
- Take the SAT I in the spring of your junior year! Juniors can take the SAT here at YC in a comfortable and familiar environment March 23 (deadline to register is Feb 13). You may take this test more than once to improve your score. Go to the [College Board](#) website for more information. Juniors are encouraged to take at least one college admission test during the spring of junior year. Register early, at least 6-8 weeks ahead, for the SAT or ACT. If you wait, you run the risk that the test center you want will be filled.
- Encourage your parents to attend College Information Night here at York Catholic on October 27, 2022, and April 27, 2023 at 6:30 PM. The YC counselors and a college representative will speak about the college selection process. Your parents may find this very helpful, especially if you are the first in your family to be applying to college.
- Attend the College Financial Aid Night at York Catholic on Monday, October 24, 2022 at 6:30 PM. A financial aid specialist will be on hand to explain the process and to answer questions. Parents are encouraged to bring their tax information from 2021 and stay for the FAFSA Completion workshop following the information session.
- Mock Interviews: All Juniors will participate in a 10-minute mock interview at York Catholic, with a human resource professional from the York community, on April 18-21, 2023. Juniors will receive more information about the mock interviews in early April.
