

Course Selection Timeline 2023-24

Course Selection for the upcoming school year begins with classroom information sessions per grade level. Mrs. Hand and the Guidance Department will visit classrooms to distribute paperwork, talk about course offerings, and explain the course selection process step by step. The schedule for grade level visits is as follows:

Grade 7	Monday, February 13
Grade 8	Tuesday, February 14
Grade 9	Friday, February 3
Grade 10	Wednesday, February 8
Grade 11	Thursday, February 9

Grades 7 and 8: Classroom teachers will talk with classes and students following information sessions, providing recommendations and guidance to students as they look to the year ahead. Students have until February 24 to return selection forms with teacher and parent signatures. Students in grade 7 and 8 will complete online course selection in classrooms under the supervision of Mrs. Hand and the Guidance Department.

Grades 9-11: Classroom teachers will talk with classes and students following information sessions, providing recommendations and guidance to students as they look to the year ahead. Students will have until February 24 to complete online course selection independently in Focus. There is no need for students to print as in years past; the Studies Office will print, and teachers will review and sign. Those signed forms will be distributed to students in homeroom on Monday, March 13; students are asked to take them home for close review and parent signature. All signed forms are due back to homeroom teachers on Friday, March 17.
