YC students interested in color guard will audition at New Member Band Camp. We will teach you the skills you need to audition.

YC students who are instrumentalists need to play at least at an intermediate level. Students who are entering into 7th or 8th grade or who are new to marching band, will need to audition. Please email Ms. Mezza to set up a time for an audition. Possible audition dates are Friday, May 12, from 3:15-6:30 PM and Saturday, May 13, from 8:00 AM-12:00 PM.

Instrumentalists, who are not yet at the performance level necessary to compete, are welcome to be a Runner. Runners help the band with props, attend football games and competitions, and play music with us in the stands. The hope is that Runners will be ready and willing to march with the band in future seasons.

- Summer Wednesday evening rehearsals
- 12-14 days of Band Camp 8:00 AM-4:00 PM
- Practices 3 days a week during school
- Friday night football games; home and away
- 6 Saturday competitions throughout season
- Community and school events
