Scheduling Reminders:

- Course Selection is open January 29 February 23 in the Focus portal.
- The State of Pennsylvania requires 4 credits in English, and 3 credits in Science, Mathematics, and Social Studies for graduation
- Course provisionals will be reevaluated on May 10th and approval granted only if the student meets the required cumulative average at that time.
- In the event that a student cannot be scheduled for the subjects requested, he/she will be notified by the Studies Office.
- Online registration must be completed by February 23rd.
- Printed course selection forms will be distributed to students grades 9-11 on Wednesday, March 6th.
 All forms are to be reviewed and signed by parents; signed forms are due back to homeroom teachers by Friday, March 15th.

Online Course Selection Instructions:

- Log into the student portal.
- Click on **Class Requests** in the left menu.
- Change the school year to 2024-25. The portal color will change to red, indicating that you have changed school years.
- Begin selecting courses from the drop-down box. You can quickly search for a course by clicking into the blank box below Course.
- Selections will automatically save. If a course is selected by accident, or if you change your mind, you may remove a course by clicking on the red line to the left of the course name. The system will prompt you to confirm the deletion.
- When you have finished selecting courses, remember to change back to the current school year.
