



## College Admissions Agreement York Catholic High School and York College of Pennsylvania

**York Catholic High School** is a co-educational Public or Private high school in York County, PA. **York College of Pennsylvania (York College)**, located in York, Pennsylvania, acknowledges the importance of improving access to private post-secondary education in the area. To strengthen the collaboration between these institutions, both parties have established this College Admission Agreement (CAA) aimed at increasing enrollment and supporting high-achieving students.

### **Academic Requirements and Eligibility**

York College will guarantee admission to York Catholic High School students who meet the following requirements:

1. Are a member of the York Catholic High School senior class in good academic and disciplinary standing;
2. Student(s) are on track to meet all graduation requirements (credits, service hours, etc.)
3. Complete an admission application to York College and submit all required documents;
4. Ensure that all admission requirements at York College are met at the time of application;
5. Obtained a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 unweighted GPA in academic high school courses;
6. Students planning to study Nursing must have a 3.40 unweighted GPA in their high school courses, have reached Algebra 1, 2, and Geometry for mathematics, and have three lab sciences (for example, biology, chemistry, and physics) with at least a "B" average.
7. Students planning to study Engineering must have reached pre-calculus for mathematics with a minimum of a "B" average.

### **Responsibilities**

York College Undergraduate Admission Responsibilities:

1. Students who apply to York College by November 15<sup>th</sup> will receive their admission and merit scholarship decision before December 25<sup>th</sup>; students who apply after the November 15<sup>th</sup> deadline will receive their admission and merit scholarship decision before March 15<sup>th</sup>; York College will award a minimum academic scholarship for \$10,000 annually for students living on-campus (total value: minimum \$40,000). Students who commute to the campus will be awarded a minimum academic scholarship of \$7,000 annually (total value: minimum \$28,000). Once enrolled, students must meet the defined academic progress and residential status requirements to maintain their academic scholarship. Note: A higher merit award may be applied if eligible, based on the student's high school grade point average.
2. Students who visit the York College campus by January 15<sup>th</sup> of their senior year will be eligible for an additional \$1,000 grant for their first year of enrollment.

York College Graduate and Professional Responsibilities:

1. Asynchronous Online Tuition Discount. York College of Pennsylvania agrees to award a 'Partner Rate' discount of approximately 5% to graduate students, their spouses, and dependents who can provide evidence of employment with the school district. This discount applies to graduate candidates formally admitted and enrolled in Graduate Degree and credit-bearing Certificate programs within the Stabler School of Nursing and Health Professions.
2. Engaged Online Tuition Discount. York College of Pennsylvania agrees to award a 15% tuition discount to graduate students, their spouses, and dependents who can provide evidence of current employment within the school district. The Engaged Online Tuition Discount applies to graduate candidates formally admitted and enrolled in Graduate Degree and credit-bearing Certificate programs within the School of Behavioral Sciences and Education, the Graham School of Business, the School of the Arts, Communication, and Global Studies, and the Doctorate of Education Program.
3. York College Career Academy Discount. York College agrees to provide discounted access to the York College Career Academy. This discount will not exceed 50% of the independent access cost of the Coursera Career Academy.

Through this agreement, the school district agrees to the following:

1. Allow York College admission representatives to schedule visits to high school to talk with prospective students and families as requested;
2. Publicly display and promote York College information, which includes but is not limited to posters, pennants, brochures, and social media;
3. Allow York College to host one financial aid workshop on the campus of the high school;
4. Allow York College to host one Instant Decision Day per year;
5. Counsel current and prospective students and their families about the CAA with York College.
6. Disseminate information regarding the College's graduate recruitment events to its employees via email twice per calendar year.

**Review of the CAA Agreement**

York College and York Catholic High School will review interested and eligible students annually. Any changes, additions, or deletions to this agreement will be made only through mutual agreement and will not adversely affect students previously enrolled under its terms.
