Prom is open to all York Catholic students in grades 11-12, and sophomores, if invited by an upperclassman. The cost is \$65 per person (cash or check made out to York Catholic). Tickets are on sale April 7-11 from 8:00-8:15 AM and 3:00-3:15 PM in room 109. Guest Permission Forms can be found on the YC website and must be turned in at the time of ticket purchase. Attendees should discuss who they prefer to sit with at dinner so those requests can be made at the time of ticket purchase. Tables seat 8 people. Buffet includes chicken marsala, sliced roast beef, and penne alfredo. Professional portraits will not be taken the night of the dance; however, candid photos will be available for purchase through Inkrote Photography. Expectations:

Students are reminded that attending a York Catholic formal dance is a privilege and along with that come responsibilities. All formal dance attendees agree to adhere to the following expectations:

- All students must arrive no later than 5:30 PM.
- Students may not leave prior to 10:00 PM.
- Students must stay on the main floor and may not go outside.
- All dancing must be face to face. There should be no dancing front to back. Crowd surfing, lifts, slam dancing, and mosh pits are not permitted. Students may not dance in clusters to obscure the view of chaperones.
- Public displays of affection are not permitted.
- Dress Code for young ladies:
 - > Dress shoes must be worn to the dance.
 - Gowns or dresses must be worn and may not:
 - Be shorter than two inches above the knee
 - Be extremely low-cut front or back
 - Have slits higher than two inches above the knee
 - Have bare midriffs or cut outs
 - Have transparent or translucent material
 - Have nude or flesh-tone colored material as a primary or secondary base color
 - Women's pantsuit may be worn in place of a gown. All guidelines above apply.
- Dress Code for young men:
 - > Dress shoes must be worn to the dance.
 - Suit or sport coat, dress shirt, and tie are required.
 - > Earrings or other piercings are not permitted.
 - Gentlemen must be clean shaven.
- Students on the Ineligibility List are not permitted to attend. Refunds will not be provided.
- Students and guests must comply with the rules and expectations of York Catholic. Violations of these expectations may lead to parent notification and early dismissal from the dance. Refunds will not be provided.
- Students bringing guests should know that all guests will be required to show proper photo ID the night of the dance.

Prom & Homecoming Dance Guest Permission Form

It is the goal of York Catholic High School to provide a safe, secure learning environment for all its students. We recognize that learning occurs both inside and outside the classroom. In order to provide this environment, we ask that all guests who are not current York Catholic students or who have not graduated from York Catholic who wish to attend our Prom or Homecoming Dance meet the following requirements:

- Be the age of 20 or under.
- Be of the opposite sex of the YC student host.
- Be at least a sophomore in high school for Prom.
- Be at least a freshman in high school for Homecoming.
- Have no criminal record.
- Have no discipline matters pending at his/her school/place of employment/military institution.
- If the guest is a graduate or former student of York Catholic High School, a check will be done on his/her discipline record during the last year of enrollment at the school.
- Be approved by an administrator from his/her school if applicable.
- Follow the formal dance expectations of York Catholic, including:
 - All dancing must be face to face. There should be no dancing front to back. Crowd surfing, lifts, slam dancing, and mosh permits are not permitted. Students may not dance in clusters to obscure the view of chaperones.
 - o Public displays of affection are not permitted.
- Follow the dress code policies for formal dances.
 - Dress Code for young ladies:
 - Dress shoes must be worn to the dance.
 - Gowns or dresses must be worn and may not:
 - Be shorter than two inches above the knee
 - Be extremely low-cut front or back
 - Have slits higher than two inches above the knee
 - Have bare midriffs or cut outs
 - Have transparent or translucent material
 - Have nude or flesh-tone colored material as a primary or secondary base color
 - Women's pantsuit may be worn in place of a gown. All guidelines above apply.
 - Dress Code for young men:
 - > Dress shoes must be worn to the dance.
 - > Suit or sport coat, dress shirt, and tie are required.
 - > Earrings or other piercings are not permitted.
 - > Gentlemen must be clean shaven.
- Violations of these expectations may lead to parent notification and early dismissal from the dance. Refunds will not be provided.
- Present photo ID when entering the dance.
