

MEMO of UNDERSTANDING

Susquehanna University and York Catholic High School

Susquehanna University is the future-ready institution for today, invested in cultivating intellectual grounding, active learning and global citizenship for all students. Renowned as one of the finest U.S. national liberal arts colleges, Susquehanna inspires and challenges 2,200 enterprising, bright-minded students studying the arts, business, humanities and sciences. Our students seize opportunities through exceptional worldwide internships, expert-guided research and an acclaimed study-abroad program, leading to a transformative education that empowers each graduate to realize their unique potential and lead a successful and meaningful life.

Susquehanna University is excited to offer qualified students of York Catholic High School an opportunity to attend Susquehanna with a substantial academic merit scholarship that will apply each year for four years assuming a student remains in good standing.

We are grateful for the opportunity to partner with York Catholic High School to advance our mutual goal of enhancing access to high quality, private education at the post-secondary level.

The components of our partnership include, but are not limited to:

- Qualifying York Catholic High School students will receive a minimum merit scholarship of \$160,000 over four years (\$40,000 per year).
- Students and their families must complete the FAFSA annually in a timely manner in order to qualify for need-based financial aid.
- Criteria:
 - Each student must have a minimum high school cumulative academic core GPA of 3.0 to qualify.

As part of this partnership, York Catholic High School will permit a Susquehanna University admissions representative to visit with their students as many as three times annually for the purposes of sharing information about Susquehanna University's academic and co-curricular programs, the application, admission and financial aid processes, and other pertinent information. Visits will be arranged by Susquehanna University's Admission Office through the York Catholic High School Counseling Center.

York Catholic High School will display Susquehanna University information, including posters, pennants, and brochures, in the Counseling Center or elsewhere at the high school where college information is presented.



In addition, the agreement between Susquehanna University and York Catholic High School (along with Susquehanna University's logo & profile) will be displayed on the high school's "College Partnerships" webpage and in any other appropriate locations.
