Loyola University Maryland Admission Agreement

Loyola University Maryland and **York Catholic High School** share a common mission to educate young people in the Catholic tradition through rigorous academics and a focus on the development of the whole person—mind, body, and spirit. Our vision is to prepare students to learn, lead, and serve in a diverse and changing world.

As such, **York Catholic High School**, York, PA, is entering into the following admission agreement with **Loyola University Maryland** beginning with the 2025-2026 school year. This agreement will remain in place in perpetuity until one or both parties submit written notification of their desire to terminate the stated agreement.

Under this agreement York Catholic High School agrees to:

- Publicly display and promote Loyola University Maryland information which includes, but is not limited to, posters, pennants, brochures, and social media.
- Allow Loyola University Maryland admission representatives to schedule visits to York Catholic High School to talk with prospective students and families as requested.
- Provide all required admission-related documents to Loyola University Maryland's Office of Undergraduate Admission by the stated application round dates to allow for review by Loyola University Maryland's admission office prior to an official acceptance decision being offered.
- Submit a final high school transcript once available with the applicant's graduation date indicated.

Under this agreement Loyola University Maryland agrees to:

- Accept any applicant from the current graduating class of York Catholic High School that has met ALL criteria established by Loyola University Maryland's Office of Undergraduate Admission* (criteria listed below).
- Offer a minimum \$25,000 per year (with a maximum of \$100,000 over 4 years) of grant aid to each accepted student for the purposes of their undergraduate studies based on criteria previously established by Loyola University Maryland.

*Admission criteria as established by Loyola University Maryland:

- Applicants must apply and complete their application for either the Early Decision I or Early Action application deadline.
- Applicants must have earned a minimum weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher.
- Applicants must complete all academic and community service requirements for graduation and remain in good standing with York Catholic High School prior to enrollment at Loyola University Maryland.
- This agreement is established for first year, fall term, undergraduate applicants and does not include transfer applicants. It does not include direct-entry admission into any of Loyola's graduate programs including any 3+1 or 4+1 programs.
- Due to the direct-entry nature of Loyola University Maryland's Bachelor of Science in Nursing program, applicants to the Nursing program are excluded from the admission agreement

outlined above. As it does with all applicants, Loyola will review all York Catholic High School applicants to the Nursing program holistically, and students will be admitted on a case-by-case basis; however, there is not a guarantee of admission promised by the Office of Undergraduate Admission.

Applicants who do not meet the above listed requirements are still eligible for admission but are not guaranteed admission as set forth in this agreement.
