

Memorandum of Understanding

Le Moyne College & York Catholic High School

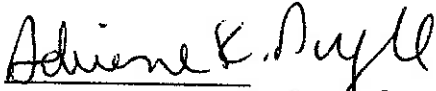
This Agreement is effective October 10, 2025 and between York Catholic High School and Le Moyne College. Through this agreement, we articulate the ways Le Moyne College and York Catholic High School can partner to enroll students interested in Le Moyne College. The components of our partnership include, but are not limited to:

1. York Catholic High School students will be guaranteed admission to Le Moyne College as a full-time, matriculated student on the condition they:
 - A. Graduate from York Catholic High School with an earned high school diploma.
 - B. Students must have completed 19 academic units (4 years of English, math, science, history, and 3 years of a foreign language). Math must include algebra 1, geometry and algebra 2.
 - C. Earn a minimum GPA of a 3.0 (85) or better.
 - Students with a GPA below a 3.0 will be reviewed on an individual basis.
 - Students may decide to submit their SAT or ACT score. If submitted, the score will only be considered if it helps the applicant gain admission
 - D. Complete an interview with a member of the Le Moyne College Admissions Team
 - Interviews can be in-person or virtual.
 - E. Students interested in the following programs will need to go through a separate admissions process:
 - i. Direct-Entry Physician Assistant Pathway
 - ii. Direct-Entry Occupational Therapy
 - iii. Dual-Degree Partnership in Nursing with Saint Joseph's College of Nursing
 - iv. Degree in Three Nursing Program with Pomeroy College of Nursing at Crouse Hospital
 - v. Applicants to the Higher Education Opportunity Program (HEOP)
2. Students who qualify for guaranteed admission will receive, at minimum, a \$80,000 scholarship over the course of their four years at Le Moyne College. This amounts to \$20,000/year in the form of a Leader Scholarship (\$17,000) and Promise Award (\$3,000). Additional aid is available to those who qualify with a completed FAFSA. Students must remain in good academic standing for scholarships to renew.
3. Le Moyne College will:
 - A. Waive the undergraduate admission fees for all applications used by Le Moyne: The Common Application, the Le Moyne Priority Application, and the Coalition Application (by Scoir).
 - B. Work with interested students in setting up an interview. Interviews can be done in-person or via zoom.
 - C. Work with the team at York Catholic High School to develop a visit schedule, college panel participation, and any other additional informational sessions.

4. York Catholic High School will:
- A. Publicize the agreement to York Catholic High School students and parents.
 - B. Agree to include the Le Moyne College admissions team in annual college advising events hosted by the York Catholic School Counseling Office.
 - C. Display Le Moyne College information, including posters, pennants, and brochures in the Counseling Office or where appropriate.
 - D. Display the guaranteed admissions partnership, including the scholarship information, on the York Catholic High School website.

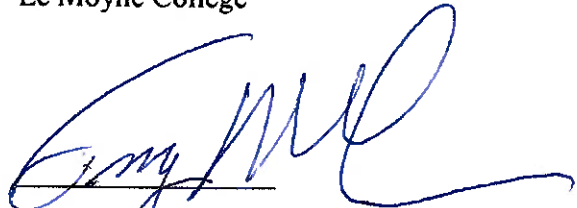
